SPECIFIC MARK dueled two across to the top of the stretch, drew off and extended his lead while being kept to task. PEANUTBUSTERNJELLY pressed the pace three across to the stretch, fell back and was no match for the winner but clearly best of the rest. ABSOLUTE TRUTH broke out and bumped at the start, chased while racing off the rail and was along for show. WIDE IDE broke in, dueled inside to the stretch, stopped and was not urged late. ANTILLES flashed speed and steadily faded from contention. WESTERN STRIDER broke in and improved position in an even effort. HUNKASLEW broke awkwardly and showed little. LOU'S FOOL bumped at the start and lacked a bid in a wide trip. CLASS N LUCK broke in, showed brief speed inside and dropped steadily.
