Footnotes

IRISH CORAL tracked to the lane, moved to the front entering the stretch and edged away through the final furlong. DE SO LONG COWBOY was asked for run on the turn, was four wide passing the quarter pole and earned the place. GENERAL RULE was steadied along the inside entering the turn, saved ground to the lane and chased then needed more. APPLICANT saved ground to the lane and then gained some through the stretch run. ARAGORN SWORD chased on the turn and needed more in the drive. JOYZEY BILLY moved five wide entering the lane and lacked a rally. LO'S IN THE FLOW raced near the inside on the turn and lacked the needed response. VIMANA moved up through the opening stages and set the pace then weakened in the drive.
