Footnotes

FRENZO just off the inside into the turn, moved to the front on the bend, was along the inside through the stretch run and proved best. WED TOO QUICK lodged a five wide bid on the turn, dueled through the lane and finished willingly while not quite good enough. DA BOSS raced six wide turning for home and finished willingly. PENTECOST stayed outside, was seven wide into the stretch and needed more. DOG ROCK saved ground and lacked the needed late response. FAT KAT DIPLOMAT was six wide entering the lane and gained some late. BALDESARRI moved up along the inside through the early stages and reached the front, saved ground and tired in the drive. MIDNIGHT COCKTAIL vied early between rivals, raced four wide into the lane and weakened. STAR PACKER vied early, raced between foes and was steadied briefly into the turn, chased then tired through the lane. JAMES four deep early, raced five wide turning for home and weakened.
