MISTRESSFORMAGNUM broke out, was unhurried early, advanced outside into the second turn, challenged for the lead, dueled, jumped tracks late and inched away to prove best. EXCESS BOOKS set the pace, responded when challenged on the turn, dueled to the final strides and yielded. PUSHBACKJACK raced in hand around the first turn, saved ground, got through along the rail leaving the turn, angled out near the eighth pole, lost momentum but held safely for show. HASTE TOTHE BATTLE lagged while racing outside, went five wide entering the stretch and failed to rally. GRAN PETER trailed the field, offered a mild bid only and improved position. OH ME OH MY bobbled at the start, raced in the middle of the pack, went four wide entering the stretch and lacked a bid. CHAPEL IN THE PARK pressed the pace to the second turn, tired and gave way. BEARS EARS also pressed the pace to the second turn, tired and gave way.
