HEROI DO BAFRA (BRZ) moved off the inside turning for home and lacked the needed rally. QUICK SCORE raced near the rail on the turn and weakened in the drive. ALONE AT LAST vied early then pressed and weakened in the drive. OTISGOLD lacked a rally. TWO ONE GUN chased inside and tired through the lane.
