KING OF THE SKY vied outside early, was taken back to stalk, rallied three across leaving the turn, vied to deep stretch and drew off. THE GOV was never far off the pace, went five wide at the top of the lane, closed steadily and got up at the wire for second. MASTER DEMAND moved up along the backstretch to vie inside, faltered past the sixteenth pole and was caught for place. OUR MAGIC COUPLE set a pressured pace, faltered near the eighth pole and dropped back. SHOTGUN WILLY pressed the pace in hand while racing between horses, fell back on the turn and finished evenly. MINT HUMOR broke slowly, went seven wide at the top of the lane and lacked a bid. GERONIMO'S GAME stumbled at the start to be off slowly, saved ground and lacked a bid.
