Footnotes

LOBO DEL DESIERTO near the rail into the far turn, raced in the four path into the lane and finished gamely while narrowly prevailing at the wire. FAR TO REACH inside leaving the backstretch, reached the front from between rivals passing the furlong marker then just missed. CLEVER CONCEPT always a factor and along the inside turning for home, chased through the lane and needed more. MODERN GENTLEMAN saved ground into the far turn, raced just off the inside turning for home and gradually improved position. BELL TOWER advanced on the final turn and reached the front between calls nearing the top of the lane, drifted some during the stretch run and weakened. TITLED NOBILITY raced five wide turning for home and lacked the needed rally. OH MEXICO set the pace inside then was in close briefly while tiring nearing the eighth pole. GREAT RIDE broke a bit slowly, trailed to the lane and lacked a rally. HARD BOURBON pressed early and vied briefly for the lead on the backstretch, remained a factor into the far turn and weakened.
