EL RANCHO broke sharply, vied two across to the turn, inched clear and was ridden out. INCLUDING GOLD was never far off the pace, rallied four wide on the turn, closed steadily and finished second best. FOREST MOUSE stalked the pace, bid willingly to threaten and hung in the lane. DARNIKO raced mid pack, went five wide leaving the turn and lacked a late rally. NO MO BAMBINO vied inside to the turn and flattened out. KING OF THE SKY angled out in the upper stretch, went seven wide in the drive and failed to menace. HECTOR stumbled at the start, stalked the pace to the turn and gave way. ANTARIAN saved ground and was through early. DESERT TRAIN had the rider check at the start, went eight wide in the drive and did not threaten. BLUE 'EM AWAY (IRE) was not a factor.
