GOT AN ITCH chased the pace, assumed command on the turn, drew clear and held well. CATCH LORRAINE lagged early, eased out at the top of the lane, bid six wide, closed well and was gaining late. TORNADO BETTY was never far off the pace, went five wide entering the stretch, bid but didn't have enough late. CRY CRY CRY saved ground, angled out on the turn, bid between horses to loom a threat and hung. HARD SEVEN broke in and bumped at the start, raced mid pack, went eight wide at the top of the lane and lacked the needed late rally. NOTIS HER raced mid pack, went nine wide at the top of the stretch and finished evenly. ZENOVIT trailed the field, bid along the rail on the turn and came up empty. FORK LIGHTNING was slow early, went ten wide at the top of the stretch and lacked a bid. BIG SWEETS sprinted clear to set the pace to the turn and stopped. PER ADOR RULING NUMBER 81, GOT AN ITCH WAS DISQUALIFIED AND UNPLACED.
