Footnotes

ENGINEER held a good position inside, bid along the rail on the turn, assumed command, drew clear, was under pressure late but held well. AMBEKAY saved ground while never far back, bid along the rail on the turn, shifted out near the eighth pole, closed well and gained late. BRITISH COLUMBIA saved ground, advanced along the rail on the turn and finished well inside to earn show while no threat to the top two. CAPT. JOE BLOW vied two across to the turn, fell back, weakened in the drive and faded from contention. ITSSULTRYINTHECAPE was never far back while racing outside, went five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. FRENCH MOON failed to threaten in an even effort. CASH RECEIPT was never far off the pace while racing between horses, lacked a bid and did not threaten. WILLYCAN lagged early, went six wide at the top of the lane, lacked a bid and was outrun. FORGET THE CAT set a pressured pace to the turn, swung wide and gave way. BROKEANDBUSTED broke slowly, lagged and showed little. NOTIME TO BADINAGE broke sharply, quickly dropped back and showed little.
