Footnotes

BLEND DAT JAZZ made all the pace, responded when set down for the drive and widened, then was kept to his task to the finish. IT'S NOT OVER YET settled inside down the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and finished well. MR. GAB chased the winner into the stretch then weakened late. MR ROJO saved ground to no avail. ROAD TO SEDONA was slow into stride and dropped far back in the early stages, raced six wide on the turn and never seriously threatened. FLOORFIRE raced six wide on the turn and was not a factor. WOOD RIVER raced four deep in the second flight down the backstretch, remained a threat to the stretch then tired. RED IMAGE moved inside on the turn and was not in contention when steadied behind a pulling up horse at mid-stretch. IRON ELLIS was a brief factor when racing five deep in the second flight into the turn, then tired. JUSTABIG forced the pace from the rail to the stretch then broke down leaving the furlong grounds and was vanned off.
