WAVERLY GIRL saved ground on the turn, stayed inside and took over from SWEET KENDALL JO in upper stretch and drove clear. SWEET KENDALL JO bumped at the start, advanced outside to the turn and drew clear, raced just off the inside into the lane and was no match while remaining clear for the place. MIZ DAYJUR chased three wide on the turn and gained some late. JOYCE T. raced near the inside and between rivals passing the quarter pole, lacked the needed stretch response. ALPARAPASSION trailed early, raced between foes in midstretch and offered a belated gain. MISS APOLLITA saved ground and lacked the needed response. ECLIPSING saved ground and lacked a bid. BOLD TIZZY broke out, moved up some entering the turn then lacked a further response.
