DIPLO five wide early, advanced four deep on the final turn and reached the front passing the quarter pole, drew well clear into midstretch then was seriously threatened. JAKEY BOY came out some leaving the gate and four wide early, moved up on the clubhouse turn and prompted the issue, raced in the three path then finished steadily late while clear for the place. LOUIS WHO three wide on the clubhouse turn, challenged between rivals heading into the far turn then needed more in the drive. CLURIOSITY raced off the inside and lacked the needed bid. PISA PLAYBOY saved ground while well placed and lacked the needed response. WESTERN STRIDER forced out some at the start, raced outside and lacked a rally. I'M THE IRISH MAN set the early pace, saved ground and weakened in the drive. JOURNEYMAN steadied in tight at the start, saved ground early, moved back inside on the final turn and lacked a stretch bid. FRENCHIE'S FAST well placed early and just off the rail into the far turn, weakened.
