OUR BOY TIMMY broke out and bumped then unhurried early, advanced outside on the final turn, raced five wide into the stretch and closed well while along in time. COACH PETE never far back, challenged for the lead in the stretch and reached the front late then was outfinished. BOLD N BAD near the inside into the far turn, raced along the rail into the stretch and needed more late. USAIN vied for the early lead, saved ground and drew clear on the final turn then weakened late. BOB'S BREW broke in and four wide early, raced in the four path into the lane and lacked the needed stretch response. CANNONVILLE was steadied while in tight and bumped between rivals at the start then lacked a rally. FOREIGN EXCHANGE near the inside into the far turn, raced in the four path entering the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BRAZILIAN SLEWS four wide on the clubhouse turn, pressed the issue three deep and weakened into the lane. ISEEISAYOUPAY saved ground while well placed to the far turn and weakened. I'MNOTEASYIMACINCH vied for the early lead and weakened nearing the quarter pole. BLUE SAVAGE stumbled at the start, raced near the inside into the backstretch and weakened. TRICKY AND BOLD pressed early three wide and between rivals and gave way after a half .
