HEY DROP THE PUCK saved ground into the turn, moved three wide into the lane and finished gamely to prevail. HIDDEN RIVER raced near the rail into the turn and four wide into the stretch, closed but was outfinished by the top one. SOUTHERNDRAMA broke out, pressed early between rivals, chased on the turn then earned the show. CARA'S ROMANCE broke out and vied early, raced inside and gave ground on the turn, moved around a rival late and gained some late. W. S. STORMY CAT four deep passing the half mile pole, reached the front on the turn and weakened in the drive. ARIAT GOLD between rivals early, vied for the lead and tired in the drive. QUEEN OF HENNESSY failed to menace. EXTRA COIN raced four wide into the turn and tired.
