DARL'S GEM vied inside to the second turn, drew away and extended his lead while being kept to task. GRANDPA ROY raced close to the pace, rallied four wide into the second turn to loom a threat, hung late and was all out for place. NORTHERN BLOOD broke awkwardly, lagged while never far back, bid five wide and was gaining for place. BENSON was crowded at the start, raced in the back, went widest in the stretch and offered a mild bid only. OUTRAGEOUS LIMIT saved ground, was blocked from the second turn through the upper stretch and was empty once clear. FAVORITE MEETING vied between horses to the backstretch, was taken back to stalk inside and had nothing left for the drive. CITIZENS BRIGADE vied outside to the second turn and tired. MEDICINE CREEK was not a factor.
