### Footnotes

JOE BLACK SANDY up close early, raced four wide turning for home and finished gamely to prevail. SANDYNECK up close inside, stayed on the rail and reached the front in upper stretch then continued on gamely to the wire. CLAY W. WOODSTOCK trailed early, raced six wide into the stretch and finished well. ENGINE SIXTY NINE prompted the early issue, moved to a narrow advantage on the turn, was three wide and between rivals into the lane, moved out passing the eighth pole and was not good enough. ROCKY ROAD saved ground and lacked the needed late response. LEESIDER set the early pace, saved ground on the turn and weakened in the drive. TONIGHT AT ELEVEN off the inside on the turn, raced in the four path into the lane and tired.
