**Footnotes**

SERVER moved up inside to vie to the turn, drew off for a clear lead and held well. BANKER'S D LIGHT raced in the back inside, rallied through traffic on the turn, eased out for the drive, closed well and narrowed the gap. CLAIM THE THRONE was never far back, rallied four wide on the turn, bid willingly and was outfinished for second. CITY VENTURE advanced to the turn, got through along the rail, bid but didn't have enough late. MAGAZINE LANE raced close to the pace, got through along the rail on the turn to get within striking distance and hung. TRULY HIGH showed good early speed while wide, dropped back on the turn and continued in a steady effort. DIAMOND DAN vied three across to the turn, fell back and faded through the stretch. FOURTH OF GOLD was outrun in an even effort. CATQUIT broke slowly, saved ground and was outrun. DARYAMAR (FR) was outrun in a wide trip. MIGHTY TANGO vied between horses to the turn and gave way. TUFFACT'N was not a factor.
