Footnotes

RISESEASTSETSWEST between rivals passing the quarter pole, raced three wide into the lane and chased then prevailed at the wire. ELLA'S KITTEN vied early outside a rival, moved inside on the backstretch and edged away some into upper stretch then just missed. LORD CALEZAAR broke a bit awkwardly, was four wide into the stretch and needed more. RICH'S BOY prompted down the backstretch three wide, chased to the lane and tired. NOBLE VISION vied early inside then up close saving ground, was checked while getting out briefly nearing the quarter pole, stayed inside and weakened in the drive. BRAZILIANO prompted between foes on the backstretch, chased then was checked in tight nearing the quarter pole dropping back. RUNAWAY CAL three wide into the far turn, moved five wide nearing the top of the lane and lacked the needed response. Following a stewards inquiry, NOBLE VISION was disqualified from fifth and placed last for interference in the vicinity of the quarter pole.
