Footnotes

ARCH LADY advanced outside on the backstretch to share the lead going to the second turn, battled past midstretch then steadily drew clear under a drive after that. ELMINE set a pressured pace between rivals from the beginning, tried hard through the lane but wore down in the deep stretch. DEVIOUS DAME was kept close inside, angled out four wide into the second turn, provided a mild bid in the drive and was clearly best of the rest. V'VILLE LADY pressed the pace three wide, lost her path leaving the half pole, was checked, altered out five wide leaving the second turn and had little left. SLAM INN dueled for the early lead inside for six furlongs but came up empty for the drive. GOLDENITA DANCER was quickly outrun and stayed far back. WALT'S HEAVEN was an inside factor on the first turn but soon faded once onto the backstretch. After their review, the stewards did not allow an objection lodged by the rider of V'VILLE LADY alleging interference from ARCH LADY on the backstretch to stand.
