Footnotes

A J'S LADY SLEW drifted out on the first turn, advanced between horses on the backstretch to gain the lead going toward the second turn, was pressured by RAG TIME DOLLY from inside past midstretch then shed the latter under a right whip late. RAG TIME DOLLY was kept close, went for the lead just off the rail on the second turn, battled inside A J'S LADY SLEW past the furlong marker, was no match for that one late but held onto the place. ALL DASH settled early, picked up her pace three wide to gain a striking position on the second turn, leveled off the final furlong and just lasted for third. DINNER AT LIDO'S unhurried early, made her move outside ALL DASH on the second turn and raced with that one to the wire. BLOOMING BLUFF carried out on the first turn, pressed the pace from outside A J'S LADY SLEW, took the second turn five wide then flattened out for the drive. ADORABLE ROSE inside through the early going, angled out on the second turn, lost considerable ground fanning out six wide into the stretch and only passed beaten ones from outside. GLOWING MISS a forward factor not far off the rail, could not keep up through the second turn, split rivals going to the eighth pole then flattened out further. MARTINIS ATMIDNITE vied for the early lead inside, could not contain A J'S LADY SLEW going to the halfway point and came up empty the last quarter mile. EL PASEO broke inward, was steadied, steadied again in heavy traffic going to the first turn, split rivals shortly thereafter to battle for the lead between horses, faltered on the second turn and lost contact with the field through the stretch.
