RIVER SLANEY well placed early and just off the inside turning for home, raced between foes late and finished gamely while prevailing at the wire. SPOKANE DANCER lodged a three wide bid nearing the quarter pole, raced in the four path entering the lane and reached the front then just missed. ZOZENSUAL saved ground into the far turn, moved three wide turning for home and finished gamely. LONELY AND FREE pulled early, challenged for the lead on the final turn and continued on willingly while not good enough. JADEN IN EXCESS set the pace, raced just off the rail turning for home, came in bothering a rival passing the eighth pole and was steadied dropping back. MOTHER'S SAUCE saved ground and was steadied nearing the eighth pole then lacked a rally. CANDY LADY BAR up close while saving ground, raced along the inside into the lane and was steadied when impeded at the eighth pole dropping back. Following a stewards inquiry, JADEN IN EXCESS was disqualified from fifth and placed last for stretch interference.
