LIL STORMIN TORIE reached the front heading into the turn, showed the way to the lane and edged away in the drive. REASON TO CRY vied early stages, chased on the turn then was no match in the drive while second best. SHAMUS ON ME saved ground to the lane, eased off the inside during the stretch run and lacked the needed late response. HOLLYWOOD MISTRESS chased five wide and tired in the drive. SIMPLY ANGELINA chased three wide on the turn and weakened. BLOOD DIAMONDS broke out some and in tight briefly heading into the turn, moved inside on the bend and offered a belated response then was vanned off. SOUTH SIDE SALLY raced just off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed bid. SHESOURKINDAGAL raced four wide on the turn and lacked a stretch bid. SHOT FOR GRANDMA raced off the inside and lacked a bid. ARIAT GOLD bumped at the start, raced in the three path turning for home and tired. GRIN N WAGER IT chased four wide on the turn and tired.
