PERKINSVILLE showed the way to the lane, widened urging then was not seriously threatened. PREACHER'S THREAT raced five wide turning for home and finished steadily while second best. FOREST SOUNDS raced in the four path entering the lane and lacked a solid response. SEATTLE MEMO well placed and four wide into the lane, weakened in the drive. TRIPLE NINE chased and weakened in the drive. DESERT MORN lacked a rally. TRIBAL HILL raced near the inside on the turn and lacked a response. DON'TTELLPETE was steadied while inside on the turn then was not urged through the lane. SCARLATTI chased early, moved off the inside on the turn and tired. RUN FORREST was eased on the turn then walked off.
