Footnotes

ALL SAINT vied around the first turn, drew away for a clear lead and held safely under steady urging. FOX IN THE HOUSE lagged early, bid inside on the second turn, closed steadily to narrow the gap and finished second best. ONE CALL raced mid pack, bid five wide, didn't have enough late and was all out for show. LIMESTONE EDGE raced close to the pace, bid between horses entering the lane, lacked the needed rally and was crowded near the wire. LESSON IN DECEIT dropped inside to save ground, was unhurried early, offered a mild bid and improved position. BOUNDLESS CAT vied around the first turn, fell back to stalk, had nothing left for the drive and faded through the lane. RULE BY FORCE stalked the pace to the second turn, tired and gave way. C S I IOWA failed to threaten in an even effort. HEZAMAZING showed good early speed along the rail, was through early and dropped back.
