STRUM BUM vied for the early lead, drew clear on the turn then proved best in the drive. MR. INSTIGATOR well placed while saving ground, bid along the rail in the stretch then was not good enough. BEFORE THE PROM saved ground on the turn and offered a mild stretch response. QUARTA COROA (BRZ) three wide into the turn, lacked the needed bid. MINERO DE ORO vied early, pressed and weakened in the drive. SEDONA SLICK chased off the inside and tired. MELO raced just off the rail on the turn and lacked a bid. HANGER THIRTYEIGHT was eased back nearing the turn, trailed then was eased across the wire.
