FIRST CAUZIN stalked the pace while racing inside, eased out at the top of the lane, closed steadily and inched clear in deep stretch. OZILDA'S GLITTER set the pace past the sixteenth pole and was outclosed to finish second best. NEW GUN IN TOWN pressed the pace, dropped back on the turn but held for show. LADNER LAD raced outside early, bid inside, was crowded and had the rider steady past the eighth pole and closed some once clear. A CUT ABOVE was crowded at the start, raced mid pack outside and lacked a bid. SINCITY GLOW saved ground, bid inside, was blocked and crowded past the eighth pole and failed to menace. CAN IT BABY stalked four across to the turn and gave way. LARSZILLA stalked the pace three across to the turn and gave way. POLLYBQUICK showed little and failed to contend.
