GUIDED WAVE raced outside, bid five wide leaving the turn, closed steadily, wore down her rivals and got up late. RARE SUNSET vied inside to the turn, inched clear, led to deep stretch and was outclosed. SOUTH OF FRANCE saved ground, eased out for the drive, bid willingly and just lasted for show. ROLLIN STOCK broke awkwardly, was blocked briefly at the top of the stretch, angled out and closed well. PYOTE was never far back, got through inside to loom a threat and hung. SWEET ON CASH trailed the field, went wide in the drive and failed to menace. BEWITCHING GEM vied between horses to the turn and gave way. NOOK AND GRANNY vied three across to the turn and gave way.
