Footnotes

YES HE'S A PISTOL was a bit slow into stride after the start and trailed around the first turn, stayed inside to the far turn, fanned six wide while quickly moving nearing the stretch, lodged his bid and drove clear late. ONERY DOLLARS settled some after the start, had to wait nearing the quarter pole when racing behind horses, found room to lodge his bid near the furlong marker and gamely earned the place. MY JON JOHN also had to wait behind horses near the quarter pole, found room to bid between foes in upper stretch then was outfinished for the place. NO LAUGHING MATTER was five wide into the first turn, stayed five wide on the far turn then loomed a threat into the stretch then lacked a solid late response. BORN A LEGEND vied for the lead from between foes around the first turn then settled back, bid into the far turn then tired the final furlong. HALO'S ROCKET was three wide around the first turn, was four wide on the far turn then tired in the drive. ROBBOS COURAGE cleared the field on the first turn, fell back some once headed nearing the quarter pole and tired. TRANSIT OF VENUS moved up along the inside near the half-mile marker, stayed inside for the drive and tired.
