SOUVENIR WINNER was in a bit tight at the start, set the pace, drew off leaving the turn for a clear lead and held well under mild urging. RICH MOCHA broke awkwardly, slowly, trailed the field, went seven wide at the top of the stretch, closed with a rush and was gaining late. ALWAYS REMEMBERED pressed the pace, hung in the lane but held safely for show. BOLD DEFENSE was in a bit tight at the start, raced mid pack, bid and hung. BIG SHOWDOWN bumped at the start, raced outside, went six wide at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. MENTMORE broke sharply, stalked the pace outside to the turn, weakened and faded through the stretch. DR MACKEE bumped at the start, showed speed to the turn and gave way. IN SHIP SHAPE raced close to the pace along the rail, was through early and dropped back.
