WHY NOT BE PERFECT tracked down the backstretch, challenged for the lead on the final turn, dueled through the lane then finished well while drawing out late. TOUCH THE SUN set the pace, responded willingly in the drive then was no match late while holding the place. WHERE'S THE REMOTE outside into the backstretch, lodged a three wide bid on the final turn and chased, was in the four path into the lane then needed more. HURRICANE LAKE trailed early, lodge a four wide bid on the final turn, was five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. SARATOGA BOOT saved ground early, was brushed while between rivals entering the far turn, was just off the rail into the lane and lacked the needed stretch bid. JAIVAL saved ground into the far turn and lacked a rally. JAMAICAN MEMORIES well placed inside, lacked a bid then tired through the lane. NO IT AIN'T in good position early, raced in close briefly between rivals entering the far turn and weakened.
