ROMO TIME between rivals on the clubhouse turn, moved to the front on the backstretch, drew clear turning for home then held to the wire. SURFLINER well placed early, raced in the four path entering the stretch and finished gamely. SPENSIVE'S IMAGE along the inside on the backstretch, raced in the two path turning for home then finished willingly while needing more. FASTBALL vied early, saved ground and chased then weakened in the drive. POP THE CORK trailed and inside into the far turn, lacked the needed rally. CAPTAIN MAGIC steadied early, raced near the rail and lacked a rally. MACHO QUITO three wide on the clubhouse turn, pressed the issue and tired through the lane. YOU MAKE ME BLUE outside into the far turn, was unable to avoid a fallen rival turning for home and unseated the rider. MARK OF MISCHIEF steadied early, raced forwardly placed, was steadied again in traffic turning for home then fell. The stewards posted the inquiry sign concerning the spill prior to declaring the original order of finish official.
