TASTE'S SIS settled inside while close to the pace, bid between horses on the second turn and got up late in an all out effort. TABLE MESA pressed the pace, bore out leaving the second turn, continued to drift despite right handed urging and went willingly to the wire. FLICKER OF GOLD was crowded at the start, trailed the field, rallied around the far turn, closed well and was gaining fast late. VICTORINA held a good position outside, rallied around the second turn, was carried out entering the stretch, continued to be carried out a bit through the drive and went willingly to the wire. CHRISTMAS SHIP pressed the pace outside, was being carried out on the turn, angled back in and closed steadily. BRIECAT set a pressured pace to deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. LITTLE GYPSY had the rider check on the first turn, raced in the back and lacked a bid.
