ROGUE RIVER pressed the pace, challenged for the lead on the turn, drew off past the eighth pole and was ridden out. KAFWAIN SECRET M D was checked along the rail on the first turn, raced close to the pace inside, eased out on the far turn to bid between horses, couldn't gain and finished second best. THE BARTON BOY appeared a bit washy in the post parade, set a pressured pace to the second turn, weakened in the drive but held safely for show. JACK'S ROMA stalked four wide, went six wide in the drive and lacked the needed late response. FAVORITE MEETING raced in the middle of the pack, bid, hung and failed to menace. BALLEET WAY was unhurried early, went seven wide at the top of the lane and lacked a bid. HOLD THE ADVANTAGE saved ground, bid along the rail on the second turn and had nothing left for the drive. HAITIAN was slow early, went eight wide in the drive and lacked a bid. T J AND COMPANY raced in the middle of the pack in an even effort and failed to threaten. WESTERN STRIDER pressed the pace three across, tired into the turn and gave way.
