TAYLORS DEAL moved to the front between rivals passing the half mile pole, showed the way to the lane just off the inside then edged clear under vigorous hand urging. LET'S GET CRACKIN up close early and outside in the turn, raced three wide on the bend and loomed a solid threat then was no match to the top one while second best. BORN FORCE pressed from along the inside entering the turn, continued to save ground and remained clear of the rest. MAKORS FINALE bobbled to be away awkwardly, raced in traffic on the turn while nearing the inside, eased out some in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. SILVANUS advanced between rivals entering the turn, moved in in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. AZ RIDGE broke in, raced four wide on the turn and lacked a rally. NOBYJO showed the early way, raced off the inside into the turn and weakened through the lane. RIO CUCHARA three wide and between rivals into the turn, raced five wide into the lane and tired.
