YOUNG THOMAS raced in close outside, rallied four wide on the second turn to challenge for the lead and drew off past the sixteenth pole. RIGHTEOUS THUNDER was unhurried early, went seven wide in the drive, closed steadily and got up at the wire for second. DEPUTY'S PRIDE set the pace, responded when challenged, weakened late and was caught for place. AGGRESSION was never far back, went six wide at the top of the stretch and offered a mild bid under left handed urging. KAMEA raced mid pack, lacked a rally and failed to menace. OH LORD stalked the pace while racing inside, weakened in the drive and faded from contention. ICED CHAMPAGNE saved ground to the second turn, went wide in the drive and lacked a bid. BEST FORCE stalked the pace to the second turn, tired and dropped back. HOLD THE ADVANTAGE trailed the field and showed little.
