SLEW'S BOY brushed some with a rival, raced in the four path into the lane and responded gamely to prevail. PATRIOTIC SOLDIER brushed some with a foe, raced five wide into the stretch and finished gamely. GATWICK vied early then up close near the inside, lacked the needed late response while earning the show. RAINIER MISSILE moved up along the inside down the backstretch and reached the front, set the pace and weakened in the drive. GOIN' DANCIN up close early four wide, raced three deep on the turn and lacked the needed stretch response. EXCESS BAGGAGE prompted the early issue, raced just off the inside and weakened in the drive. FATHER JONES advanced along the inside turning for home, loomed a threat along the rail into midstretch then lacked a clear path late. FEEL THE MOMENT raced five wide into the lane and lacked a rally. PER ADOR RULING NUMBER 73, PATRIOTIC SOLDIER WAS DISQUALIFIED AND UNPLACED.
