CLEVER CONCEPT vied two wide to the second turn, dueled through the stretch and proved best in a long drive. FAR TO REACH moved up along the backstretch to vie three wide between horses, challenged on the turn, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished in a game effort. PAINTED SLEW was unhurried early, rallied around the turn, eased out for the drive, found his best stride late and was gaining fast. GLOBAL APPEAL was unhurried early while racing outside, offered a mild bid only and was not a threat. OH MEXICO moved up on the backstretch to contend four wide, fell back into the turn and faded from contention. MODERN GENTLEMAN was outrun in an even effort. LITTLE CALLTOME was not a factor. TOUGH TO CATCH vied inside, tired into the second turn and gave way.
