Footnotes

WESTERN STRIDER moved up along the backstretch to vie, assumed command on the second turn, drew clear and held safely under urging. BEARS HOME RUN was unhurried early, eased out in the upper stretch, closed and got up late for place while no threat to the winner. HEROI DO BAFRA (BRZ) was never far back, rallied five wide leaving the turn, bid, hung and was caught for second. SLIDE ROCK stalked the pace, bid inside on the turn to loom a threat and hung in the lane. EVALUATE (IRE) saved ground while racing mid pack, bid along the rail on the turn, had little left and failed to threaten. TOBIAH'S JOURNEY was hustled along to set the pace to the second turn, bore out, was steadied, dropped back and continued to drift late. STRATEGIST lagged outside, lacked a bid and was outrun. PERFECTIIONISM was through after a half and not urged in the stretch.
