ZENARO advanced outside to challenge for the lead turning for home then drew clear under strong left handed urging. DAKOTA DUSTY tracked early, moved to the front between calls nearing the top of the lane, angled out some in midstretch and continued on willingly while second best. SMART MASTERPIECE trailed and outside into the lane, offered a late gain for the show. LISTEN YOU FOOL hung a bit wide into the clubhouse turn, lacked the needed rally. WHISTLE CAT dueled for command outside a rival, drew clear between calls on the second turn then tired through the lane. BARTON HILL off the inside into the clubhouse turn, saved ground down the backstretch and had no rally. KNUCKLEBUSTER dueled for the lead inside a foe, weakened on the second turn then faded through the lane and was eased across the wire.
