FANZOCA stalked the pace between rivals, was taken to the rail into the second turn, swung outside SILK N DIAMONDS into the stretch, rallied three wide and got up in the final strides. SILK N DIAMONDS vied for the early lead outside CHOPIN'S FIRST, shook off that one nearing the end of the first half mile, drew clear and was taken inside on the second turn, all out the final furlong but was narrowly outfinished in a game effort. ARCH LADY settled between rivals early, picked up her pace on the second turn, was angled in leaving that bend, lacked room behind SILK N DIAMONDS through the upper stretch, got through inside the latter inside the last sixteenth and closed well. DANCING FRUITION broke outward, was steadied to avoid DEVIOUS DAME, steadily advanced outside, took the second turn four wide, rallied in the lane but drifted out badly the last sixteenth. DEVIOUS DAME well placed outside from the early going, took over second three wide on the second turn but wore down between horses in the lane. CHERYL AGAIN AGAIN two to four wide, was never a factor. CHOPIN'S FIRST broke in the air, was rushed up between rivals to vie for the early lead from inside but had little left after a half mile.
