SIBERIAN PUNCH was steadied on the first turn, held a good position, rallied four wide entering the stretch, closed steadily and got up in the final strides. FROSTED DONUT chased the pace, challenged three across on the turn, duelled under steady urging and was outfinished in a game effort. USAIN was hustled, sprinted clear to set the pace to the final strides and was outfinished. STRIKER BEAN broke out, raced wide early, bid five wide leaving the turn, went willingly to the wire and narrowed the gap. OUTLAW LEADER saved ground, got through along the rail on the turn to loom a threat and hung late.. BOLD N BAD lagged early, went six wide at the top of the stretch and lacked the needed late response. TOMMY'S TREASURE failed to threaten in an even effort. EDMONDSBYTHESEA broke a bit slowly, was never far off the pace, advanced to the far turn to loom a threat, had little left and faded through the stretch. FOREIGN EXCHANGE raced mid pack, stopped into the second turn and was not urged late.
