Footnotes

POINT OF ORIGIN stalked the pace inside, awaited room on the turn, bid three wide between horses, assumed command mid stretch and inched clear in a driving finish. BITTER CREEK stalked the pace, went four wide leaving the turn, couldn't match strides with the winner and finished second best. TWO ONE GUN raced mid pack, angled in on the turn, bid along the rail, dueled for the lead, yielded but was clearly best of the rest. BEFORE THE PROM was slow early while saving ground, eased out for drive, went six wide and lacked a rally. COLD SURF set the pace, responded when challenged to duel to mid stretch and faltered. FIRMLY ORIENTED was hustled along to show speed to the turn and gave way. COWBOYSANDINDIANS (IRE) fell back early, went seven wide in the drive and lacked a bid. CORNROW WALEASE broke sharply, showed brief speed while racing outside and gave way.
