BLAST'EM chased the pace, lacked the needed late rally and was outfinished for second. BEAR FAMOUS TRIP was never far off the pace, went five wide in the drive and failed to rally. C S I IOWA bobbled and was impeded at the start, saved ground and lacked a bid. STORMY SEATTLE was outrun in an even effort. TONY THE PONY broke awkwardly and was impeded at the start and was not a factor. TWO TURNS lunged and was crowded at the start, trailed the field and showed little.
