FREE ACTION advanced five wide on the turn and reached the front nearing the quarter pole, drifted some during the stretch run then drew out. DEL MAR DRAMA lodged a four wide bid on the turn and chased then was no match to the top one while second best. QUICK SCORE raced six wide on the turn and lacked the needed stretch response. DARK VADER raced five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. VISION OF ROSES saved ground on the turn and lacked a rally. GOLDEN MIST three deep early, vied for the lead and tired in the drive. AMPHITRITES GIFT lunged out at the start, raced in the four path into the lane and lacked a bid. MATUCO (ARG) saved ground and vied for the lead then tired in the drive. NOTIME TO BADINAGE moved out on the turn and lacked a bid. AL GHAZI'S PENNY pressed the early issue between rivals, was steadied passing the quarter pole and weakened.
