LORNA DARE eased out on the turn and moved to the front three wide nearing the top of the lane then responded to left handed pressure and edged clear. RUNWAY DANCER in a bit close at the start, advanced inside into the lane and challenged for the lead then continued on willingly while no match late to the top one. TOUGH TO REPETE vied for the early lead outside a rival and weakened in the drive. KITTYBANGBANG moved out for the drive and lacked the needed bid. DIESEL DANCER bumped at the start, raced five wide turning for home, moved in and weakened. RYAN'S ANGEL came out some at the start then lacked a rally. GENTLE RIDGE came out slightly at the start, vied for the early lead inside, raced just off the rail turning for home and tired. HOUSTON'S DEAL bumped lightly at the start, lacked a response.
