R SWEET VALENTINE led throughout and held safely while being kept to task. APRIL was allowed to settle, saved ground, eased out on the turn, bid five wide and closed well to get up late for place while no threat to the winner. SCALPERS DREAM pressed the pace two across, fell back along the backstretch to stalk, lacked the needed late response and was outfinished for second. KATIE'S TEN was never far off the pace, bid between horses on the turn to get within striking distance and hung. SPOKANE DANCER was never far back while racing three across, bid four wide on the turn, had little left and failed to gain. LIMELIGHT LADY saved ground, had no stretch response and dropped back.
