SOMMELIER SMARTY was unhurried early while saving ground, eased out on the turn, challenged three across, dueled through the stretch and prevailed in a long drive. TAPADERO broke awkwardly and bumped at the start, set the pace around the first turn, vied inside, dueled through the stretch under steady urging and was outfinished in a game effort. SANDYNECK bumped at the start, moved up into the backstretch to vie two across to the stretch, weakened and faded from contention. MERLE T saved ground, lacked a bid and was outrun. SAX was crowded on the first turn, stalked the pace while racing outside, went five wide entering the stretch and had no stretch response. TONY THE PONY lugged out on the first turn, raced within striking distance to the second turn and gave way.
