Footnotes

IRISH ROVER vied for the lead while three wide early, bid to the lead midway on the turn, widened the lead then was kept to his task to the finish. CASE SETTLED was between foes down the backstretch, took the two path in the start and finished well. NORTHERN THUNDER forced the early pace, was five wide into the stretch then lacked a solid late bid. SIRIUS STAR settled some after the start, was six wide into the stretch then lacked a solid bid. VYING FOR VICTORY showed brief speed after the start, raced along the rail, stayed inside for the drive and lacked a bid. STORY'S END fell back some after the start, was four wide into the stretch but was never a serious threat. SMARTY FAWCETT had no early speed, raced along the rail and didn't threatened. PERFECT MAJESTY vied between foes then tired in the stretch. AUSPICIOUS STAR vied for the lead from the rail and also tired in the drive. ALNASHMI was only a brief factor into the turn then dropped back and tired.
