GREEN SECRET was a bit headstrong leaving the chute but set all the pace, responded late to a challenger and held on at the wire. JAIVAL was near the early pace then was allowed to settle back, stayed inside and lodged his bid at mid stretch and finished well. DOUBLE SHUFFLE rated after the start, angled out some nearing the stretch, was four wide into the stretch and finished willingly. EDGERIN J saved ground into the far turn, took the three path into the stretch and also finished willingly. GRANDPA ROY forced the pace outside the winner to the stretch and tired. TRICK OF THE NORTH rated off the leaders, moved to the rail for the stretch and lacked a bid. MOUDEZ (IRE) settled after the start, was through entering the stretch then was vanned off afterwards.
